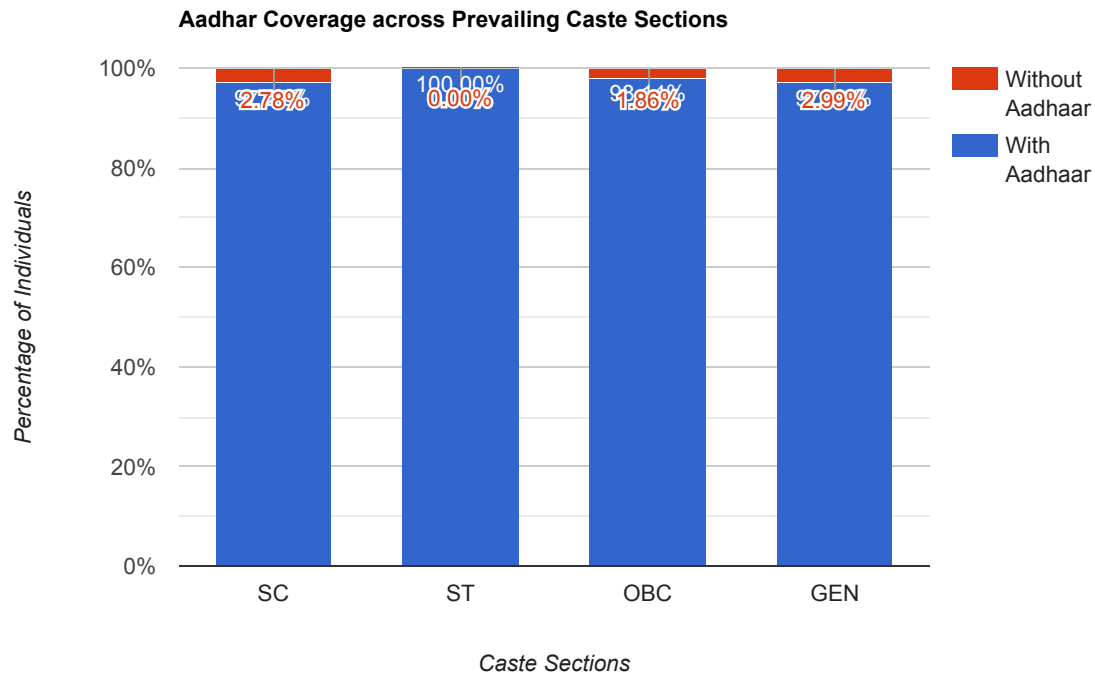

**Bank Coverage across Prevailing Caste Section**



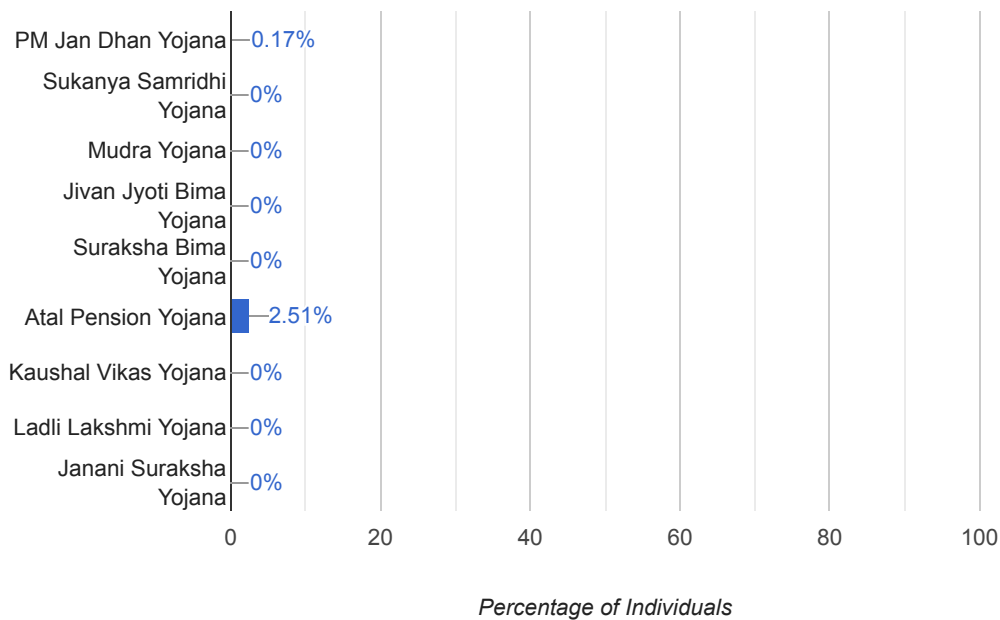

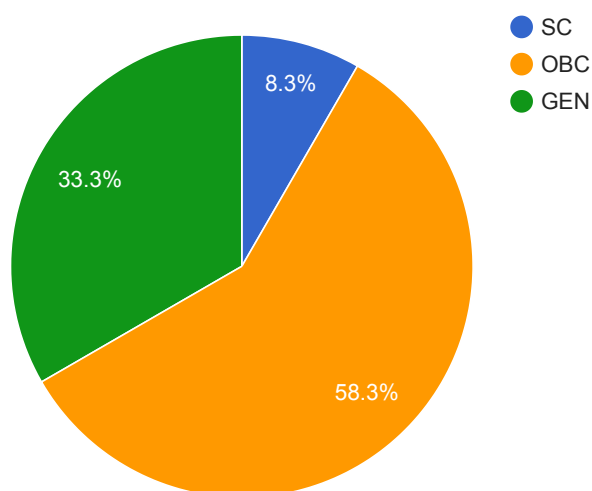

Migration Percentage across Caste Sections



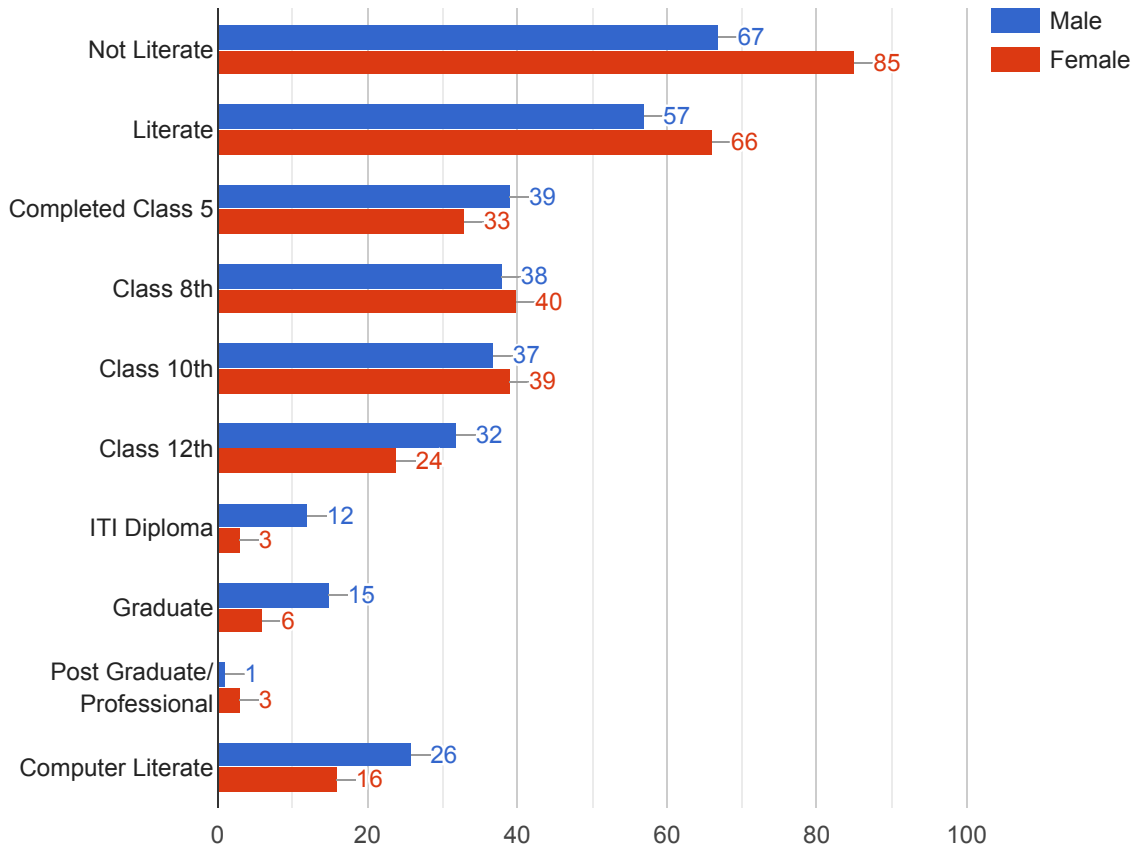

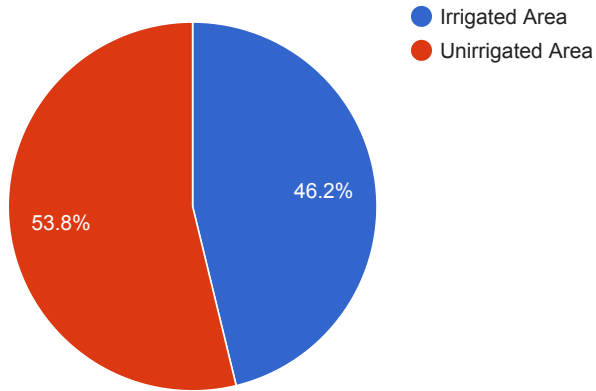

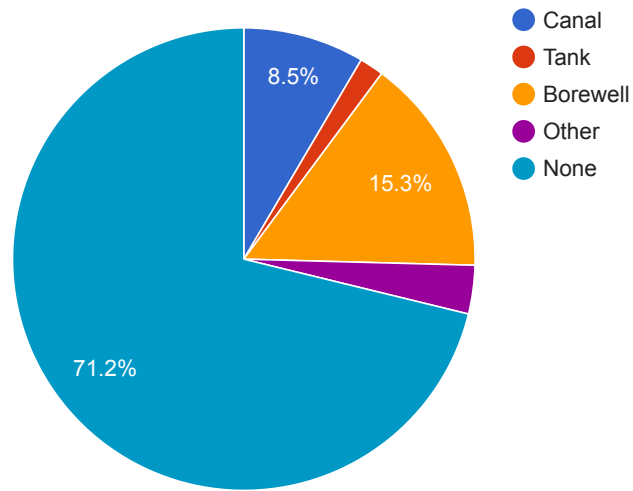

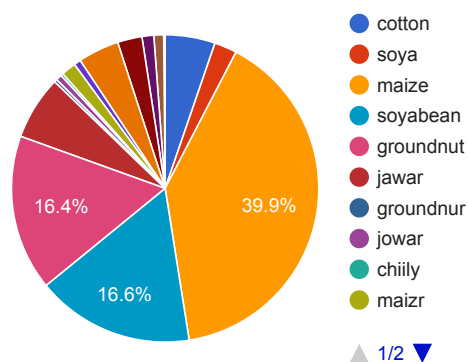

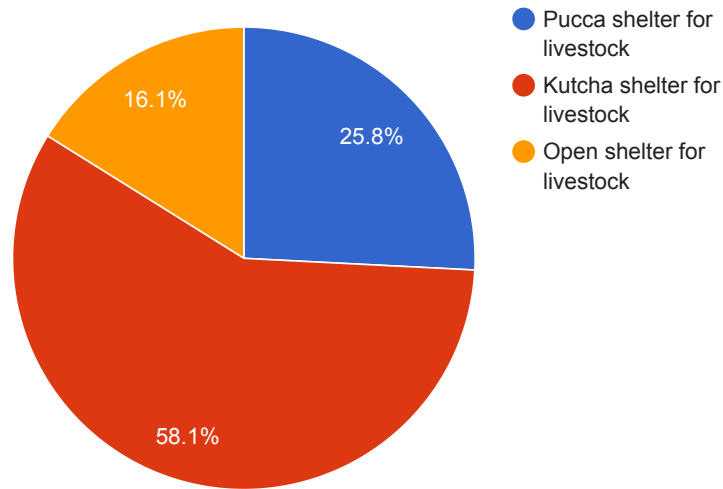

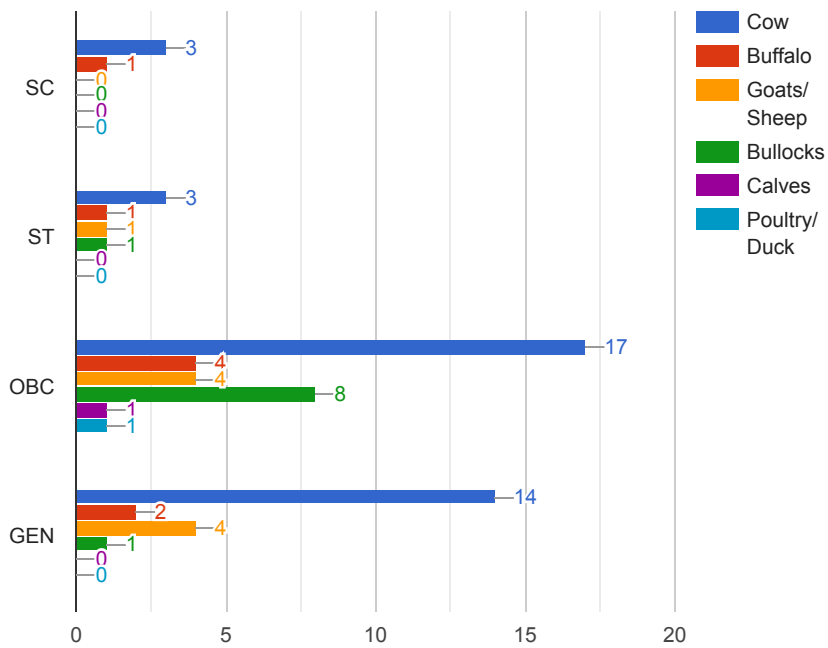

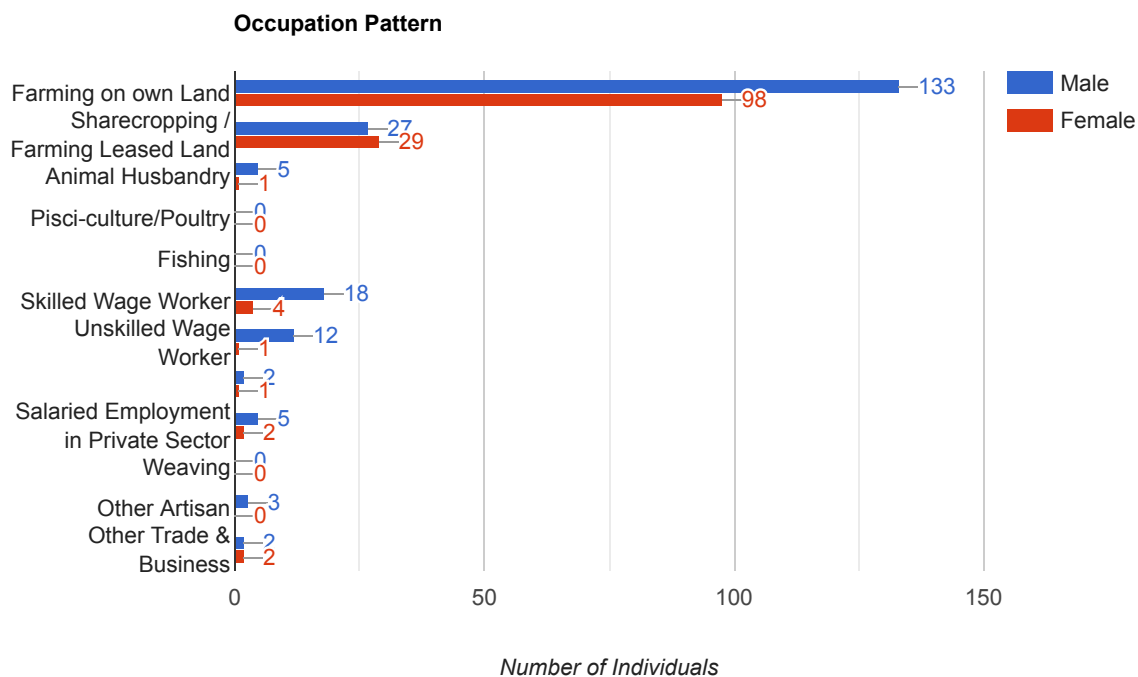

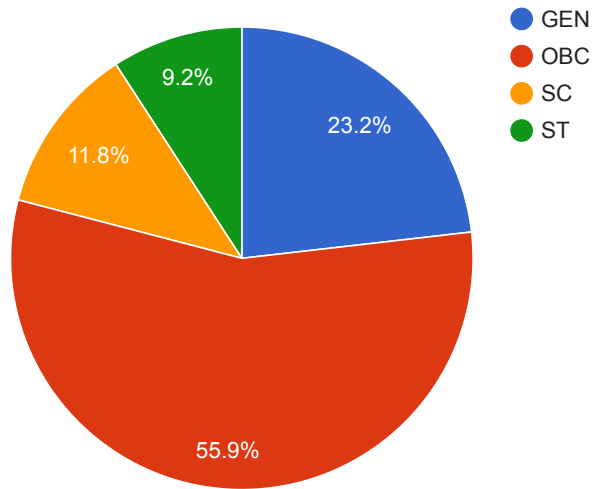

Lighting Source and usage in Village

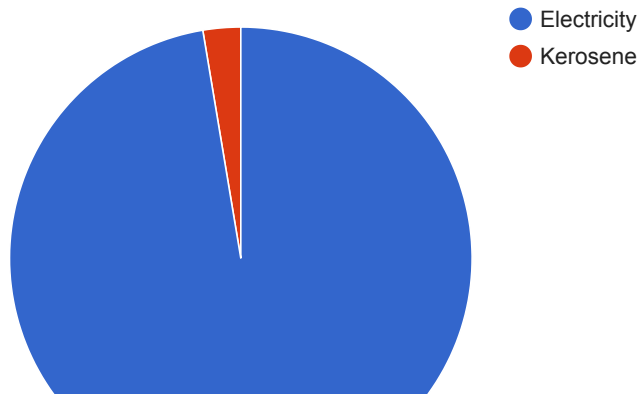

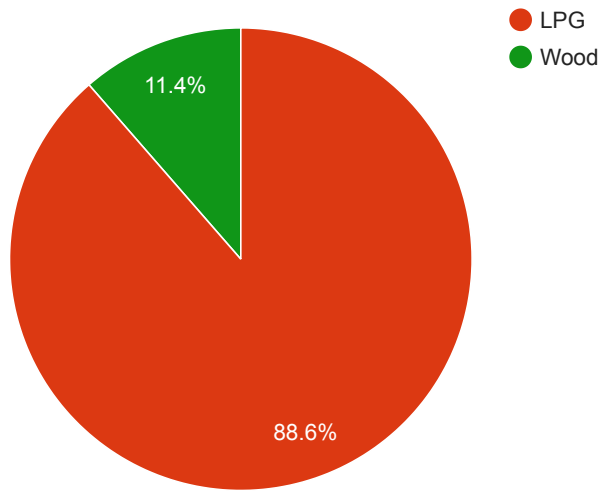
