



#### Poverty Line across prevailing caste sections






#### Use of toilets across different prevailing caste section in village







Irrigated area and unirrigated area of total cultivable area










#### **Occupation Pattern**







Total Electric Load of common village facilities: 4.79(kW)



#### Cooking Fuels Usage in Village


